National Philanthropy Day Awards

The award selection committee, consisting of area nonprofit and marketing professionals, will choose a worthy recipient in each award category. The decisions of the award selection committee are final and will be shared with nominators on or around September 1. The names of all nominees will not be published in any event materials.

Outstanding Lifetime Philanthropy Award – presented to an individual or family, either in honor or memory, who are recognized widely as community philanthropists and have a long and proven record of making a significant impact in their community through financial support and volunteerism/leadership for a variety of organizations.

Outstanding Philanthropist Award – presented to an individual or family who have demonstrated exceptional generosity through direct financial support, outstanding civic and charitable responsibility, and whose generosity encourages others to take philanthropic leadership roles on a local, national and/or international level.

Outstanding Fundraising Volunteer Award – presented to an individual or couple who has demonstrated exceptional leadership skill in coordinating and motivating groups of volunteers for major fundraising projects and is recognized for sharing their time and talents with area nonprofit organizations.

Outstanding Philanthropic Corporation Award – presented to a corporation or its corporate foundation that has demonstrated outstanding commitment through financial support and through encouragement and motivation of others to take leadership roles toward philanthropy and community involvement.

Youth in Philanthropy Award – presented to an individual or group of young people (college students or younger) who has demonstrated outstanding commitment to the community through direct financial support, charitable programs, volunteerism and/or leadership in philanthropy.

Outstanding Fundraising Professional – presented to an individual fundraising professional who practices his/her profession in an exemplary manner. The recipient must have at least five years of professional fundraising experience, evidence of quality of leadership and being a team player, a commitment to continuing professional development, and commitment to fundraising and philanthropy through volunteer service and financial support of non-profit organizations.

1. How does the nominee support and get involved with your organization and other non-profit organizations? What has been the nominee's impact on your organization and mission?
2. How does the nominee reflect the values important to your organization?
3. How does the nominee support, encourage, and motivate others to get involved with and/or take leadership roles in philanthropy (i.e., challenge gifts, matching gifts, lead gifts, volunteering, etc.)?

The awards committee will select the award recipients based on these award criteria, so please be specific in your responses and touch on each of these points. *All nominations and related information submitted with the nomination shall become the property of AFP-Northeast Wisconsin Chapter.*

We request that each award recipient and nominator be available between September and October, 2018 to have a video vignette taken at the Medical College of Wisconsin-Green Bay to be shown at the National Philanthropy Day event.

Please note that preference will be given to those who reside and contribute to organizations in Northeast Wisconsin and to those who have not received an award in the recent past. See the following pages for a list of all previous National Philanthropy Day award recipients.
